#### Level(s) EU Survey

Aim: to obtain feedback on two key aspects of your project's test of Level(s):

- How useful was the structure of Level(s) for your building assessment?
- How user friendly were the selected indicators and tools, together with the supporting guidance?

Before completing the survey: we recommend reviewing the questions with the project team in order to get the experience and feedback of the whole team.

Testers must submit via EU Survey by 30th September 2019.



#### **Structure of the survey**

- Part 1: Expectations and previous experience
  - expectations and motivations
  - ✓ initial experience of the team
- Part 2: How Level(s) is designed
  - ✓ the added value of the different levels and reporting options
- Part 3. The value of Level(s) to stakeholders
  - ✓ the value Level(s) had for different stakeholders involved in the test
    Public sector, the financial community, designers and their clients.
- Part 4: Your use of the test indicators and tools
  - the specific experience of using each of the indicators and life cycle tools selected for testing



#### Level(s) EU Survey: example questions

Requirement to participate in an on-line survey of their experience using Level(s) and how it meets the original aims of the Commission

Topics you can expect to be asked about:

- ✓ How it has been used, for what purpose and at which project stages
- ✓ The extent to which it drove or helped identify performance improvement opportunities and/or project benefits
- ✓ How accessible and useful the guidance and reporting tools are and how it compares with other tools and guidance that are available
- ✓ The extent to which it encouraged you to tackle new aspects of performance and the experience of doing this



# Level(s) EU Survey: example questions

- ✓ The extent to which it was possible to use it with in-house expertise
  or if external expertise was needed
- ✓ The time, cost and data needs and at different levels.
- ✓ The relative value of the using the different levels
- ✓ Other recommendations for improvement and support needs



#### **Test phase web forum**

A platform for participants to **share experiences and information** in relation to specific topics

Discussion forums may be initiated:

- ✓ by JRC following survey, helpdesk and webinar feedback
- ✓ at the request of participants to JRC or DG ENV in order to tackle
  specific topics
