Profile of the Level(s) testers

More than 120 registrations at close of registration in 2018

- 62 residential building tests
 - 45 new build, 17 major renovations
- 57 Office building tests, 16 major renovations
 - 41 new build, 16 major renovations

What it doesn't do

✓ Makes the calculations required to generate a result

Updates have been made based on errors or problems identified by Level(s) testers
