Results submitted by testers (1)

Total numbers of testers	136	
Testers submitting results	79	58%
Confirmed non-submissions	13	10%
No response (3 prompts via email)	44	32%
% managing to submit by EU region	1	

North	42	71%
West	47	53%
East	11	27%
South	36	58%



Results submitted by testers (2)




